MECHANIC OF THE YEAR: A person who has shown, not simply a mechanical aptitude on their own behalf, but an unselfish attitude and a willingness to help others.

DRIVER OF THE YEAR: A driver who has shown particular abilities and results not only on the track at BKC, but in their attitude and actions off the track. This award is given to the competitor who best exemplifies karting and BKC.

KARTER OF THE YEAR: This is given to a BKC member who embodies all the qualities important to karting and BKC. It is this person who has unselfishly furthered the club's objectives through their actions and because of whom the club is better off.

KARTING FAMILY OF THE YEAR: This is given to a BKC member family who embodies all the qualities important to karting and BKC. This family has unselfishly furthered the club's objectives through their actions and because of them, the club is better off.
